VILLAGE OF HILLSBOROUGH

BY-LAW NO. 14

A BY-LAW RELATING TO STREETS, THEIR USE AND PROTECTION

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of the Village of Hillsborough, as follows:

INTERPRETATION

- 1. In this By-Law
 - (a) "street" means and includes highway, gutter, curb, boulevard, sidewalk, space between property lines, parks, parkways, driveways, squares, bridges, viaducts, off-street parking lots amd places used by the public for pedestrian and vehicular traffic.
 - (b) "person" means and includes individuals, corporations, partnerships, associations, or societies.

PROTECTION OF THE STREETS

- 2. IT SHALL BE AN OFFENCE under this By-Law for a person
 - (a) to place upon any street or open plot of ground within the Village of Hillsborough any rubbish, parts of trees, snow, ice, sand, or any other material which has accumulated in or upon property.

PENALTY

Any person who violates any provision of this By-Law is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a penalty not exceeding One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), for each offence.
