A BY-LAW RESPECTING LOITERING AND BEGGING

 $\underline{\text{WHEREAS}}$ The Municipalities Act, 1973, R.S.N.B., c. M-22 provides as follows:

- s. 91.1 (1) No person shall loiter unless such person, when required to do so, justifies his reason for doing so.
- s. 91.1 (2) No person shall beg from door to door or in a public place.
- s. 91.1 (3) Every person who commits an offence under
 this section is liable on summary conviction
 to a fine not exceeding Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars
 and in default of paymentis liable to
 imprisonment in accordance with Subsection 31
 (3) of the Summary Convictions! Act.

 $\underline{\tt BE\ IT\ ENACTED}$ by the Village Council for the Village of Hillsborough as follows:

- 1. Sections 91.1 (1) and 91.1 (2) of the Municipalities
 Act, 1973, R.S.N.B., c. M-22 is in full force and
 effect in the Municipality of the Village of Hillsborough.
- 2. This By-Law comes into effect on the date of the final passing thereof.
