

VILLAGE OF HILLSBOROUGH

BY-LAW NO. 17

A BY-LAW RESPECTING LOITERING AND BEGGING

WHEREAS The Municipalities Act, 1973, R.S.N.B., c. M-22 provides as follows:

- s. 91.1 (1) No person shall loiter unless such person, when required to do so, justifies his reason for doing so.
- s. 91.1 (2) No person shall beg from door to door or in a public place.
- s. 91.1 (3) Every person who commits an offence under this section is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars and in default of payment is liable to imprisonment in accordance with Subsection 31 (3) of the Summary Convictions' Act.

BE IT ENACTED by the Village Council for the Village of Hillsborough as follows:

- 1. Sections 91.1 (1) and 91.1 (2) of the Municipalities Act, 1973, R.S.N.B., c. M-22 is in full force and effect in the Municipality of the Village of Hillsborough.
- 2. This By-Law comes into effect on the date of the final passing thereof.
