

BY-LAW NO. 23

A BY-LAW RELATING TO THE ENFORCEMENT OF BY-LAWS FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF THE VILLAGE OF HILLSBOROUGH .

WHEREAS under the authority of the Municipalities Act, R.S.N.B., 1973, C. M-22, s.11(1)(a), the Village of Hillsborough is authorized to enact a By-Laws "regulating its procedure";

AND WHEREAS pursuant to the Municipalities Act, R.S.N.B., 1973, C. M-22, s.101 "an information for the breach of a by-law shall be laid in the name of the clerk of the municipality or such other person as is designated for that purpose by the council";

AND WHEREAS it is not expedient for the clerk of the municipality to lay informations for the breach of by-laws;

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Council of the Municipality of the Village of Hillsborough, as follows:

1. This By-Law shall be known as By-Law No. 23 and may be cited as the "Enforcement By-Law".
2. In this By-Law:
  - (a) "Village" means the Village of Hillsborough;
  - (b) "Peace Officer" means a member of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police or the New Brunswick Highway Patrol;
  - (c) "By-Law" means a by-law of the Municipality of the Village of Hillsborough.
3. Any Peace Officer is designated and may lay an information for the breach of a by-law.
4. Any Peace Officer is the agent of the Municipality of the Village of Hillsborough for the purposes of the Petty Trespass Act, R.S.N.B. 1973, C. P-8.01 and amendments thereto.
