BY-LAW #73

A BY-LAW OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ALMA

REGULATING THE INSTALLATION OF CROSS-WAYS OR CULVERTS AND THE MAINTAINING OF DITCHES ALONG VILLAGE STREETS

Be it hereby enacted by the Council of The Village Of Alma as follows:

1. Ditches along all streets within the Village Of Alma will be maintained by the Village or by persons authorized by the Village.

2. No person shall excavate, landscape, install crossways or culverts or fill a ditch, or any part thereof, along a street within the Village Of Alma, unless approved in writing by The Village of Alma.

3. In keeping with the Dept. of Transportation Access Point Policy dated April 1, 1994, The Village Of Alma will no longer supply or install culverts or crossways. This will be done at the expense of the property owner.

4. The Village of Alma is not responsible for paving over a culvert or crossway. Any damage to asphalt or concrete caused by culverts shifting from frost or other reasons will not be the responsibility of the Village Of Alma.

5. Any damage to existing culverts caused by construction in the area or by any other means, shall be the responsibility of the person or persons causing such damage.

This By-Law replaces any previous policies regarding culverts and crossways in The Village Of Alma and comes into force on the date of Final passing thereof.
