BY-LAW NO. 8

A BY-LAW RESPECTING THE BY-LAWS OF THE

MUNICIPALITY OF RIVERSIDE-ALBERT

THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF RIVERSIDE-ALBERT

DULY ASSEMBLED HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- l $\,$ (1) Subject to subsection (2) , all by-laws of the municipality herefore enacted are repealed .
 - (2) This by- law does not apply to

 - (b) # 3A Provincial Dog Regulation By-Law
 - (c) # 4 Planning advisory Committee
 - (d) # 5 Reserve Fund Fire Dept.
 - (e) # 5A To Establish a Reserve Fund For the Fire Dept
 - (f) # 6 To Amend Number of Councillors
 - (g) # 7 Water Rates and Charges
 - (h) # 21 Building By-Law
 - (i) # 22 Subdivision By-Law
 - (i) # 23 Zoning By-Law
 - (k) # 20 Basic Planning Statement
 - (1) # 10 Unsightly Premises
- 2 In every by-law of the municipality, unless the context otherwise requires
 - (a) "by-law means a by=law of the municipality;
 - (b) "clerk" means the clerk of the municipality
 appointed under section 75 of the Municipalities
 Act;
 - (c) "corporation" means the municipality :
 - (d) "council" means the mayor and the councillors of the municipality:
 - (e) "councillor " means a member of the council other than the mayor
 - (f) "member of the council" or "member" means a person elected to the council; and
 - (g) "muncipality" means the Village of RIVERSIDE-ALBERT

- Where a by-law creates an offence but does not state the penalty, a person who violates that by-law is liable on summary conviction to a fine of not more than two hundred dollars and in default of payment thereof to imprisonment for not more than thirty days.
- 4. (1) Where a by-law imposes a fine for a violation of a provision of the by-law, the person alleged to have committed that violation, may pay before the institution of proceedings against him for the violation a sum equal to the minimum fine prescribed for the violation to the clerk and upon that payment the person is not liable to be prosecuted for a violation.
- (2) The clerk shall issue a receipt for a payment made under subsection (1) and transmit all payments received by him under this section to the municipal treasurer.
- 5. This by-law comes into force on the date of final passing thereof.
