

BY-LAW NO. 8

A BY-LAW RESPECTING THE BY-LAWS OF THE

MUNICIPALITY OF RIVERSIDE-ALBERT

THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF RIVERSIDE-ALBERT

DULY ASSEMBLED HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1 (1) Subject to subsection (2) , all by-laws of the municipality herefore enacted are repealed .

(2) This by- law does not apply to

(a) #1-By-law to regulate procedure at meetings

(b) # 3A - Provincial Dog Regulation By-Law

(c) # 4 - Planning advisory Committee

(d) # 5 Reserve Fund Fire Dept.

(e) # 5A To Establish a Reserve Fund For the Fire Dept

(f) # 6 To Amend Number of Councillors

(g) # 7 Water Rates and Charges

(h) # 21 Building By-Law

(i) # 22 Subdivision By-Law

(j) # 23 Zoning By-Law

(k) # 20 Basic Planning Statement

(l) # 10 Unsightly Premises

2 In every by-law of the municipality, unless the context otherwise requires

(a) "by-law means a by=law of the municipality ;

(b) "clerk" means the clerk of the municipality

appointed under section 75 of the Municipalities Act ;

(c) "corporation" means the municipality :

(d) "council" means the mayor and the councillors of the municipality:

(e) "councillor " means a member of the council other than the mayor

(f) "member of the council" or "member" means a person elected to the council ; and

(g) "municipality" means the Village of RIVERSIDE-ALBERT

3. Where a by-law creates an offence but does not state the penalty, a person who violates that by-law is liable on summary conviction to a fine of not more than two hundred dollars and in default of payment thereof to imprisonment for not more than thirty days.

4. (1) Where a by-law imposes a fine for a violation of a provision of the by-law, the person alleged to have committed that violation, may pay before the institution of proceedings against him for the violation a sum equal to the minimum fine prescribed for the violation to the clerk and upon that payment the person is not liable to be prosecuted for a violation.

(2) The clerk shall issue a receipt for a payment made under subsection (1) and transmit all payments received by him under this section to the municipal treasurer.

5. This by-law comes into force on the date of final passing thereof.

READ A SECOND TIME this 11 day of March 1992.

READ A THIRD TIME AND DONE AND PASSED IN COUNCIL this
11 day of March 1992.
