1. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Rochon called the meeting to order at 9am.

2. ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA

IT WAS MOVED by *Councillor Jonah* and **SECONDED** by *Councillor Elderkin* to accept the agenda.

4. YEAR-END FINANCIAL RESOLUTIONS

Resolution - Hillsborough Utility Operating Reserve Bank Account

IT WAS MOVED by Councillor Jonah and SECONDED by Councillor Elderkin THAT:

WHEREAS the Hillsborough Utility of Fundy Albert Utility does not have an Operating Reserve bank account;

BE IT RESOLVED that a bank account be opened for the Hillsborough Utility Operating Reserve

MOTION CARRIED

Resolution – 2023 Transfer to Hillsborough Operating Reserve

IT WAS MOVED by Councillor Jonah and SECONDED by Councillor Elderkin THAT:

WHEREAS \$110,000 was to be put in Hillsborough Utility's Operating Reserve for Hillsborough Water Exploration; and

WHEREAS legislation only allows 5% of your previous year's budgets be invested in operating reserves; and

WHEREAS Hillsborough Utility's funds allow for the transfer to be completed;

BE IT RESOLVED that \$46,000 be transferred to Hillsborough Utility Operating Reserve

MOTION CARRIED

Councillor Ereaux asked for clarification that this was being moved from the Hillsborough Utility Operating Account to the Reserve.

Mayor Rochon said yes and added it would be used for phase 1 of the Hillsborough Water Exploration.

Resolution – 2023 Transfer to Hillsborough Capital Reserve

IT WAS MOVED by Councillor Elderkin and SECONDED by Councillor Ward Russell THAT:

WHEREAS it is a requirement under the former Village of Hillsborough's agreement under the Canada New Brunswick Rural Infrastructure Fund to establish a replacement reserve fund which will be maintained for future replacement of various short life capital items that would be above and beyond ordinary maintenance and minor repairs to the new lagoon; and

WHEREAS \$4,000 was to be transferred to this fund over the course of ten years and with this year being the 10th and final year; and

WHEREAS it was budgeted to transfer \$5,500 to Hillsborough Utility's Capital Reserve; **BE IT RESOLVED** that \$5,500 be transferred from the Hillsborough Utility Operating Fund to Hillsborough Utility's Capital Reserve.

MOTION CARRIED- with a friendly amendment

Councillor Ereaux asked for clarification of where the money is coming from. **Mayor Rochon** explained that for the past 9 years it has come from the Hillsborough Utility Operating Fund set by Government for Capital Maintenance. This is the 10th and final year.

Resolution - Riverside-Albert Utility Operating Reserve Bank Account

IT WAS MOVED by Councillor Elderkin and SECONDED by Councillor Ereaux THAT:

WHEREAS Riverside-Albert Utility of Fundy Albert Utility does not have an Operating Reserve Bank Account;

BE IT RESOLVED that a bank account be opened for Riverside-Albert Utility Operating Reserve

MOTION CARRIED

Resolution – 2023 Transfer to Riverside-Albert Utility Operating Reserve

IT WAS MOVED by Councillor Elderkin and SECONDED by Councillor Jonah THAT:

WHEREAS it was budgeted that \$7,848 & \$4,320 (totalling \$12,168) be transferred to Riverside-Albert Utility's Operating Reserve for Water & Wastewater, respectively; and

WHEREAS Riverside-Albert Utility's funds allow for the transfer to be completed;

BE IT RESOLVED that \$12,168 be transferred from the Riverside-Albert Utility Operating Fund to the Riverside-Albert Utility Operating Reserve

MOTION CARRIED- with a friendly amendment

Resolution – 2023 Transfer to Riverside-Albert Utility Capital Reserve

IT WAS MOVED by Councillor Jonah and SECONDED by Councillor Land THAT:

WHEREAS it was budgeted that \$14,229 be transferred to Riverside-Albert Utility Capital Reserve; and

WHEREAS Riverside-Albert Utility's funds allow for the transfer to be completed; **BE IT RESOLVED** that \$14,229 be transferred from the Riverside-Albert Utility Operating Fund to Riverside-Albert Utility Capital Reserve

MOTION CARRIED- with a friendly amendment

<u>Resolution – 2023 Alma Fire Department Cashable GIC Purchase</u>

IT WAS MOVED by Councillor Land and SECONDED by Councillor Ereaux THAT:

WHEREAS the Alma Fire Department has a projected year end surplus of \$17,000; and

WHEREAS \$5,000 was budgeted to be transferred to their reserve;

BE IT RESOLVED that \$22,000 be used to purchase a cashable GIC

MOTION CARRIED

Councillor Ereaux questioned why a GIC was being used in this case rather than the reserve account. **Mayor Rochon** and **Councillor Elderkin** explained that this has been the practice of Riverside-Albert for some reserves and shows clearly which department it is used for. **Mayor Rochon** also highlighted the fact that GICs are an investment vehicle.

Resolution – 2023 Hillsborough Fire Department Reserve Transfer

IT WAS MOVED by Councillor Elderkin and Seconded by Councillor Land THAT:

WHEREAS the Hillsborough Fire Department has a projected year end surplus of \$22,000; and

WHEREAS \$5,000 was budgeted to be transferred to the Hillsborough Fire Department's reserve;

BE IT RESOLVED that \$27,000 be used to purchase a cashable GIC

MOTION CARRIED

Resolution – 2023 Riverside-Albert Fire Department Reserve Transfer

IT WAS MOVED by Councillor Elderkin and SECONDED by Councillor Jonah THAT:

WHEREAS \$5,000 was budgeted to be transferred to the Riverside-Albert Fire Department's reserve;

BE IT RESOLVED that \$5,000 be transferred to Riverside-Albert Fire Department's Reserve

MOTION CARRIED

Mayor Rochon pointed out that this is being transferred to the reserve. **Councillor Ereaux** questioned why it was being handled differently- not sure. He also asked about a surplus in addition to this \$5,000. **Councillor Elderkin** explained that near end-of-year fire equipment was purchased that used the balance of the budget.
