#### PROVINCIAL-MUNICIPAL HIGHWAY PROGRAM

#### PAVING IN RIVERSIDE ALBERT

**IT WAS MOVED** by *Councillor Land* and **SECONDED** by *Councillor Jonah* to rescind the motion made on October 3, 2023, to award a contract for asphalt patching to Brown's Paving.

## WATER TESTING RESULTS
