

Riverside-Albert BOIL ORDER ADVISORY

Due to elevated turbidity on September 6th, 2024, the Department of Health has advised that all residents of Riverside-Albert a boil order is in effect until further notice. Drinking water must be boiled for **ONE MINUTE** before consumption until further notice.

The Department of Health “Boil Water” procedure is as follows

- Water should be held at a rolling boil for 1 minute
- Any water to be ingested for example: brushing teeth, making ice, water used in making coffee/tea, juice or infant formulas, washing raw vegetables and cooking should be boiled.
- People whose immune system is compromised e.g. the elderly, infants, and people with transplanted organs, on dialysis, with HIV/Aids, etc. should pay particular attention to the use of a safe source of drinking water. Water, which has been properly boiled, is considered a safe source.
- It is safe for people to take showers, bathe, and use swimming pools.
- It is safe to wash dishes in hot water and soap and then air dry or use a dishwashing machine.
